




Historical Sales Chart



2015 California Hotel Sales Highlights


- o The top three median price per room markets were all in Northern California
- o At \$435,833, San Francisco County had the highest median price per room in the state
- o Orange County had the highest median price per room in Southern California, at \$134,426
- o Sacramento County had the lowest median price per room (\$45,455)
- o Riverside County had the biggest increase in the number of sales up 42%
